4. Principal/Vice Principal Report

- -Mrs. Graci welcomed our first time parents to the school council in our first time every virtual online meeting.

- -Mrs. Graci announced that Mr. Masse is also part time VP for online virtual learning as well as VP of Holy Cross.
- -Mrs. Graci reported that 290 students are enrolled in Holy Cross and about 210 online learning.

- -Mrs. Graci talked about start time and finish time at Holy Cross: School will start at 8:30am. Students can begin entering the school at 8:15am to their assigned doors and ensure physical distancing. Dismissal time: school will end at 3:00pm; however, Holy Cross will begin to dismiss students at 2:45pm by their designated doors to ensure physical distancing
- -Mrs. Graci emphasized that there is no schoolyard supervision, only cross walks and bus duty. Parents are encouraged to stay behind the fence not allowed on schoolyard, to practice social distancing, and to wear masks.
- -Parents are NOT allowed to remain in the schoolyard before or after the school drop off times.
- -Mrs. Graci mentioned that DPCDSB has sent out a self-screening for COIVD and to follow the steps before coming to school
- -Mrs. Graci provided the parent council with a video presentation she appreciates all of us being here
- -School Cash on line is in the process of reimbursement parents with pizza refunds.
- -Mr. Masse is gave reassurance that he is always walking around the school, checking with measuring tape the distance between kids and the desks, always making sure school is clean and if any questions to call the school or email with any concerns

5. Teacher's Report: Mrs. Fava

- -Welcome Mrs. Fava to the parent council, glad to be on board
- -Brief overview on doing their best to help the kids, making sure they are following Public Safety and Health mandated by Peel Public Health

- -RAZ Kids: Reading A to Z a program on line app (download) Kids go to their reading level, monitor's their level and better reading getting them to a higher level. Money spent \$1096.77.
- -RAZ Kids is good to use in classroom or at home to keep them reading.

- -Mrs. Graci asked parent council for renewal of RAZ Kids for January 2021 for Grades 1, 2, 3 money to be spent \$1,425.00.
